

SBA Social Media Policy

General Rules

1. Any postings on SBA social media platforms must abide by the policies of the New England Law | Boston Student Handbook.
2. The following is absolutely prohibited:
 - a. Any postings containing profanity, drugs or irresponsible use of alcohol, illegal activity, or otherwise inappropriate behavior
 - b. Any postings with a reasonably foreseeable potential to involve any members of the New England Law community in any conflicts with other members of the community or third parties
 - c. Any postings that create a harassing or hostile environment for members of the New England Law community
 - d. Any postings that may have the potential to harm the reputation of New England Law
3. Anyone who does not abide by these policies will have their privileges to use the social media platforms revoked.

SnapChat

1. The President or Chair of any student organization or committee may submit a request for access to the SBA Snapchat during an event.
 - a. The request must specify the exact dates and times for which they are requesting access.
 - b. Once the request is approved, the organization will be permitted to post to the SnapChat story for the duration of the approved event.
 - c. If any posts by the organization fall outside of the permitted time frame, or contain any prohibited material, that organization's permission to use the SBA snapchat will be revoked for the remainder of the school year.
